Thank you to all Genevans who helped provide 30 sack lunches for the homeless April 3rd. The lunches were delivered to the City of Laguna Beach Alternative Sleeping Location (ASL) on Laguna Canyon Road.

We are now working on signups for May 1st. To lend a hand in making sandwiches, cutting up apples, providing baked goods and inspirational notes for the sack lunches, please visit the <u>Homeless Shelter</u> <u>Lunch</u> registration page for program details and to sign up. You can commit to just one Saturday or more depending on your availability.

As a reminder, this new monthly program is a reboot of the previous weekly program where we delivered lunches directly to the homeless every Sunday afternoon. The pandemic has forced us to pivot a bit, but it looks like this new approach thus far is proving successful. Thank you in advance for your willingness to serve!

WORSHIP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Although we are covered for our first in-person worship service May 9th, we will need ten volunteers weekly to implement the safety protocols outlined by the state. The available positions are:

- 1. Check-In Team (3 people): Registration verification.
- 2. Screening Team (3 people): Temperature checks and health questions.
- 3. Ushers (4 people): Ensures people enter and exit safely and are seated appropriately distanced.

All volunteers are required to complete a one-hour training session prior to serving which will be scheduled by your team leader. Additionally, volunteers will need to arrive a half hour prior to service time.
