FINANCIAL RECAP

January through April 2021

Our members have certainly remained faithfully committed to Geneva. Pledge revenue has exceeded the monthly budget in three of the first four months of this year! Other

positive revenue additions have come from the Presbytery in the form of grants supporting our Channel 6

outreach effort and on-campus Covid-related efforts. We also benefitted from a Federal employee retention tax credit. Expense savings are related to efficiencies in staff hours and communication costs.

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING UPDATE

Sunday, May 23rd a called Congregational Meeting was conducted via Zoom to approve a revision to the church bylaws allowing electronic meetings to be conducted for church business when necessary. We're happy to report that a quorum was established and the motion was passed. Thank you to all who participated.
