Did you know that Geneva collects used clothing and textiles? You may drop off your used textiles to the cardboard bin in the church office, and they will be donated or recycled as appropriate by **usagain**. So far, Geneva has sponsored the planting of 77 trees, saved nearly 74 million gallons of water, and has provided clothing for 616 individuals, all while avoiding the use of landfill space.

We collect non-perishable food items in the blue shopping cart on the courtyard Sunday mornings and in the office during the week.
